San Carlos Apache College—America's newest Tribal institution of higher learning—is currently recruiting outstanding adjunct faculty members for courses in a variety of academic disciplines as well as courses for personal enrichment. These include courses in: Accounting; Apache Language & Culture; Art; Biology; Business; Chemistry; College Success; Computer Information Systems; Digital Arts; Early Childhood Education; Economics; Education; English; Geography; Geology; History; Math; Photography; Philosophy; Political Science; Psychology; Physics; Social Work; Sociology; and Speech Communication. *Preference given to enrolled tribal members and veterans per tribal policy.*

Role: Under the direct supervision of the Vice President of Academic Affairs, Dr. Lisa M. Eutsey, the adjunct faculty member will teach one or more courses in his or her credentialed area to support the College's unique vision, mission, and goals.

Essential Responsibilities

- Instructs students in a classroom or virtual setting—and creates an effective and positive learning environment using teaching methods that are student-centered and culturally relevant;
- Submits course syllabi, develops course materials consistent with student learning outcomes and course competencies, grades assignments, and evaluates overall student performance;
- Plans, designs, and teaches courses—and holds weekly office hours;
- Submits artifacts for the assessment of courses and programs.

Minimum Qualifications (for transferable courses)

Education: A Master's Degree in the teaching field or masters in any teaching field with 18 graduate hours in the teaching field. Other qualifications will be considered for non-transferable/personal enrichment courses.

Experience: At least two years of quality College teaching experience **or** willingness to participate in a teaching mentoring program for one academic year.

Preferred Qualifications: A Ph.D. in the teaching field with 3-5 years of instructional experience in an academic environment. Tribal college experience preferred. Demonstrated knowledge and understanding of the historical and contemporary issues facing Native peoples.
