Placement Tests

TRANSFER STUDENTS ARE ENCOURAGED TO MEET WITH OUR ADVISOR PRIOR TO TAKING THE ACCUPLACER AND AFTER THEIR TRANSCRIPTS HAVE BEEN EVALUATED.

The Accuplacer tests you in Reading, Writing and Math to determine the class level you need to begin with. Transfer students might not require to take the Placement Test.
